Description:

Sclerosing solution to be used intravenously for the treatment of varicose veins.

Indications:

SALIJECT® is primarily used in the local treatment of medium and small varicose veins of the legs.

Contraindications:

Strictly contraindicated, as any sclerosing agent, in case of: recent, superficial or deep thrombophlebitis; varicose veins caused by abdominal or pelvic tumors; potential underlying arterial disease; renal or cardiac insufficiencies accompanied by venous stasis and dilatation; angina pectoris; local or systemic infections; hyperthyroidism; uncontrolled diabetes mellitus; deafness.

Do not administer to patients with a history of salicylates hypersensitivity.

Adverse effects:

The patient may experience a slight pain at the site of injection, followed by a mild cramp which lasts approximately 5 to 10 seconds. Pain may be alleviated by administering the sclerosing agent with a local anesthetic such as Lidocaine without epinephrine.

Precautions:

Due to the risk of necrosis or sloughing following extravasation, **SALIJECT®** should be used only under strict medical supervision, preferably by a physician accustomed to the sclerotherapy technique.

Dosage:

Dilute **SALIJECT®** with lidocaine 1% without epinephrine, to yield a solution containing approximately 30% of Sodium salicylate. To be administered by IV injection. Do not inject more than 2 mL in each site; respect a 5 to 8 cm interval between two injection sites. Do not inject more than 8 or 10 mL per treatment.

Storage:

Store at controlled room temperature, (15 - 30°C), protect from light.

10 mL vials

Each vial contains:

Sodium salicylate:	570 mg/mL (5.7 g/vial)
Benzyl alcohol:	10 mg/mL (preservative)
Sodium metabisulfite:	1.0 mg/mL
Hydrochloric acid or	
Sodium hydroxide:	for pH adjustment
